Important information for September 2023

Please do not forget to book your child's lunch via ParentPay before Wednesday 30th August. If lunch has not been pre booked you **MUST** provide your child with a packed lunch. Due to the high volumes we are expecting for lunch in September there will be no exceptions, if no booking have been made you will be expected to bring your child to school with a packed lunch from home.

From September 2023 breakfast club **MUST** be booked and paid for in advance via ParentPay. This needs to be booked by the Wednesday before in the same way as booking lunch. There is a £2 charge per child per day. Children with have the option to have a healthy breakfast of either toast or cereal free of charge. Please make sure you clear current debt.

We use ParentPay to send text messages and emails updating parents, please make sure your contact information is correct on your ParentPay account.

We return to school on Tuesday 5th September (Monday 4th is a training day)

To everyone else – have a wonderful summer and we look forward to welcoming you back in September.


