After Half Term our after school care provision Fit for Sport will be rebranding, they will be known as <u>Junior Adventures Group</u>. Parents who already use the provision will be notified directly. For more information please look out for flyers in the school reception office.



#### **Entering the School**

After half term the pedestrian gate in the staff car park will be out of use - All parents and visitors must use the new school entrance or the Cherry Lane entrance. Parents who need to visit the school office should not use this gate to get through, and parents who use the intercom will be asked to walk round to the new entrance intercom.

The middle gate on Sipson Road and gate between the car parks are no longer in use, please use our new entrance and gate on Sipson Road. This gate with its wider path leads directly to the school office, instead of the smaller middle gate on Sipson Road. There will still be three ways to enter and exit the school grounds at drop off and pick up time ~ the gate and long path from Cherry Lane, the gate by the Children's Centre leading to the Reception classes and this new gate leading to the year 3 and 4 building and the main playground. Please use this gate now when dropping children to Breakfast Club, for late arrivals, early leavers, visitors and after school collections. Morning Nursery pick up will still be from the same door but please use the gate by the Children's Centre to enter the school grounds.

#### Spare Uniform

The school are currently looking for any spare uniform that is in good condition only. There is a collection box in reception. Also any spare underwear or socks in excellent condition would be appreciated for our welfare office.

#### Lateness

There are a number of students coming in late to school. Please be aware of school start times. Reception, year 1 and year 2 start at 08.50. Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 start at 8.45

#### **Uniform/Coats**

Please ensure your child brings a coat every day. Can we please ask that you practice doing their zips so your child can put their coat on independently. Can you please ensure your child's clothing is clearly labelled with their name and class.

Due to extreme cold weather we are currently experiencing please ensure your child brings hats, gloves, scarves etc...

Please make sure Mrs. Ramsay has been updated with any changes to your child's medical condition.

# Netball Match


