

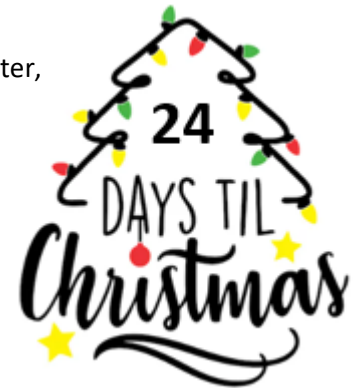

Our school day starts for Years 3-6 at 8.45am. Reception and Years 1 & 2 start at 8.50am.

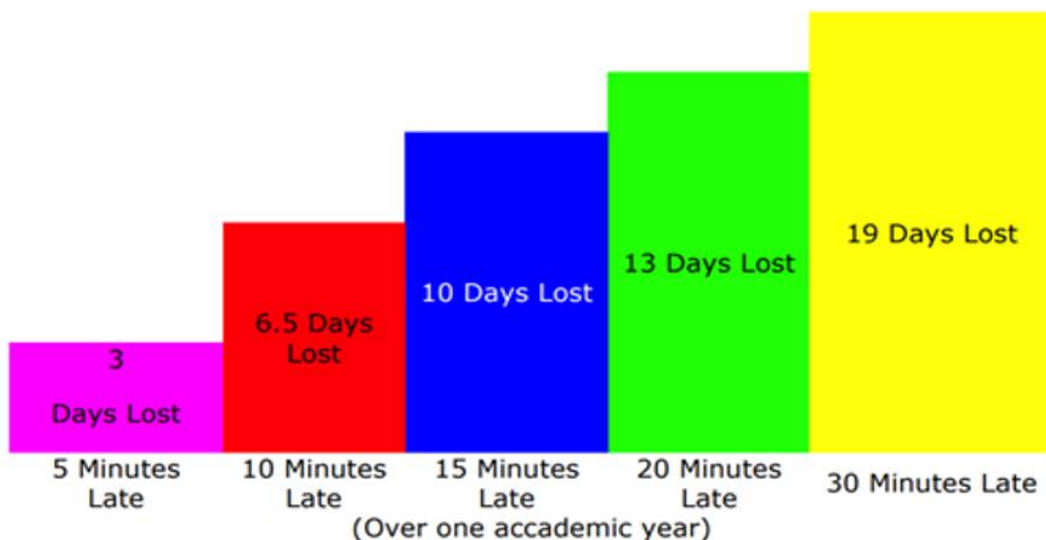
**Learning starts at this time.**
