
The Cherry Lane boys' football team put on a spectacular performance this week against Whitehall Junior School. The whole team showed great teamwork and communication which led them to an impressive win.



Escape to the garden this half term and get creative with your children!




Join us for a free fun day of creating a colourful selection of bird feeders, windchimes and mobiles from recycled materials.
