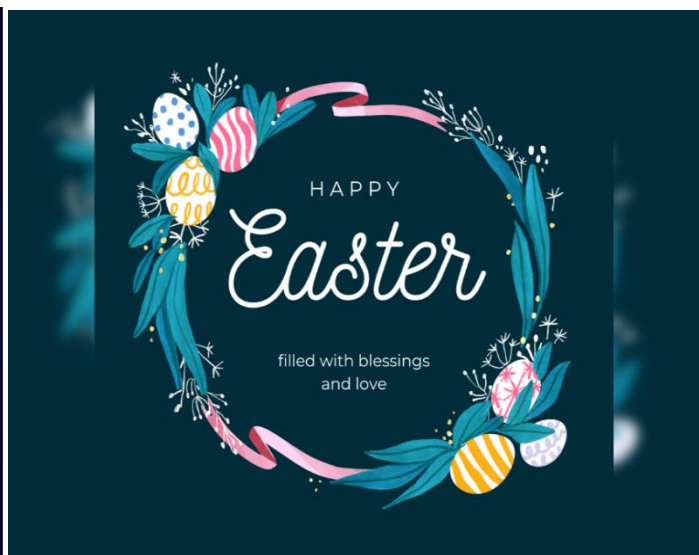

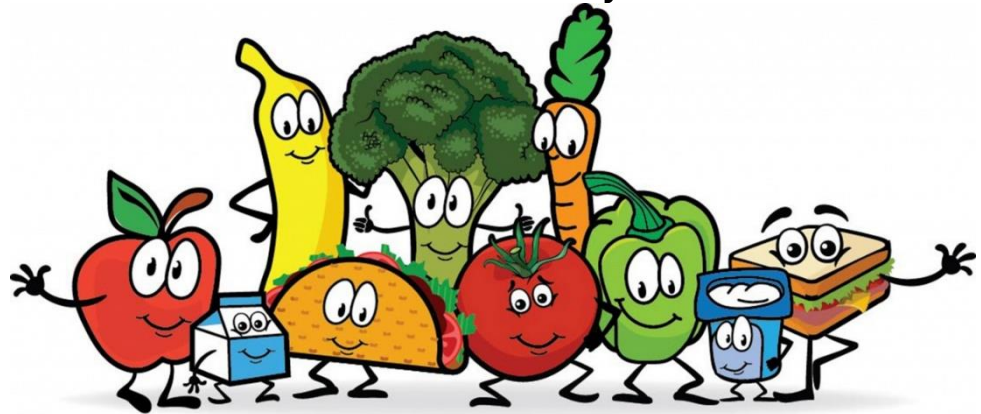

**If your child is late to school, please make sure they come to the main reception, so they can be signed in.**

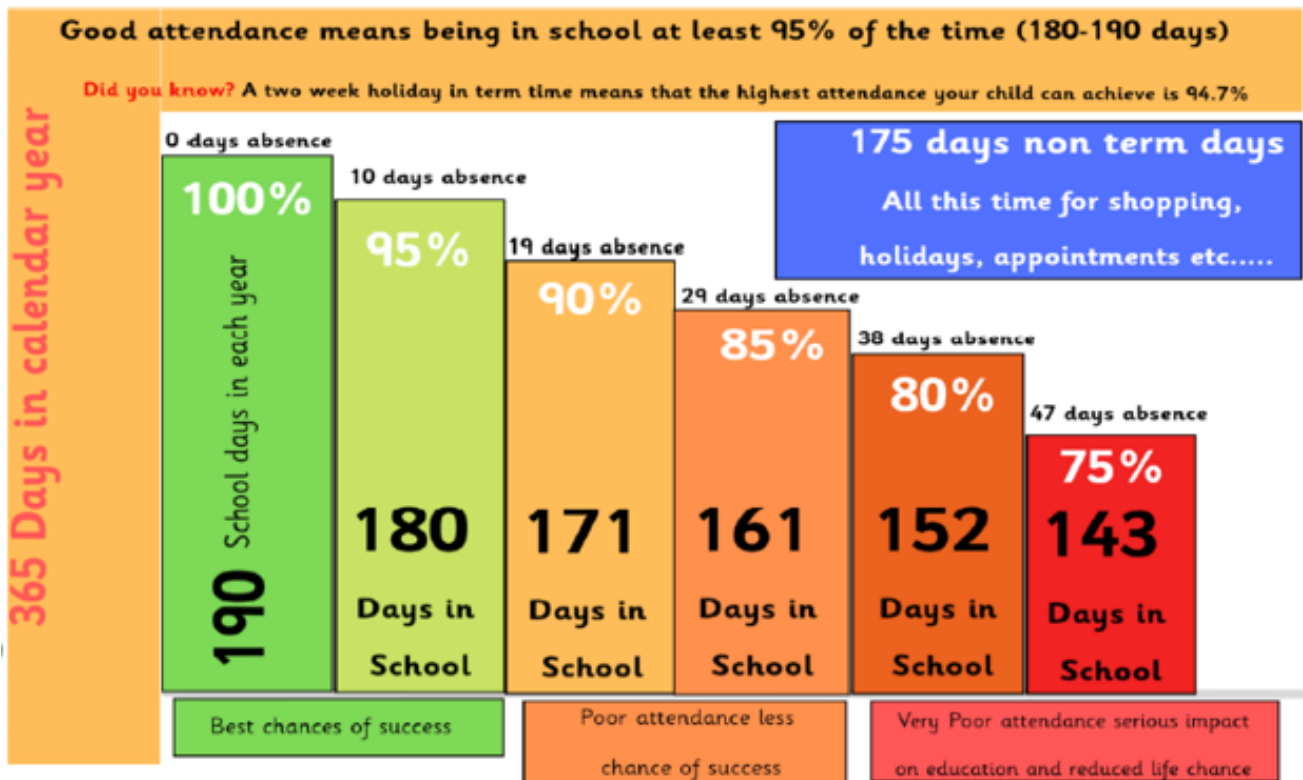
**Learning starts at this time.**
