Music: Developing Ensemble Skills

Learn to sing the song as part of an ensemble. Follow a leader/conductor Understand the meaning of the song.

Demonstrate and maintain correct posture and breath control.

PSHE: Valuing Difference

Recognise that bullying and discriminatory behaviour can result from disrespect of people's differences;

Hockey

In this unit pupils develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games. In all games activities, pupils have to think about how they use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition. In hockey pupils do this by maintaining possession and moving the ball towards goal to score. Gymnastics

In this unit, pupils use their knowledge of compositional principles e.g. how to use variations in level, direction and pathway, how to combine and link actions, how to relate to a partner and apparatus, when developing sequences. They build trust when working collaboratively in larger groups, using formations to improve the aesthetics of their performances.
