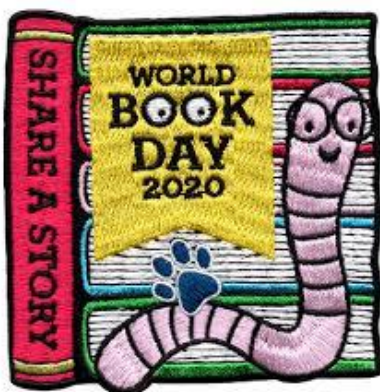

All parents have been notified that all school meals are now available to book online via ParentPay. The cut off time is midnight on every Wednesday to book meals for the following week. **Please note that all meals need to be paid for within two hours of making your selection or your pre-booked meals will be lost.**

If no meals have been booked you will have to provide a packed lunch for your child. There will be no opportunity to amend any meals after this time. Whatever is booked online will be what your child is having on the relevant day.

Coronavirus Information

Dear Parents & Carers,

I appreciate many parents and carers may have concerns over Coronavirus, COVID-19. I am writing to reassure you that the school is following advice given by the Government's Department for Education, which is being updated frequently.

We have a full understanding of the procedures we need to follow if any adults or children are suspected of having been exposed to the virus, or become unwell. The current advice is that schools stay open unless we have been given specific guidance to shut. In the meantime, we are taking all precautions we can.

If you or your child has travelled to a Category 1 or Category 2 country in the last 14 days (please see links below), we would ask you to inform us.
