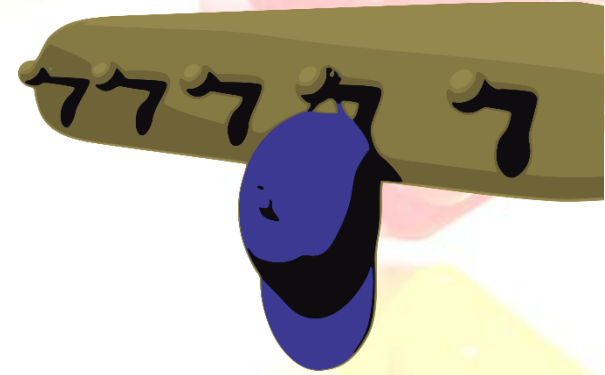




**Welcome

THE BUILDING AND YOUR PEGS

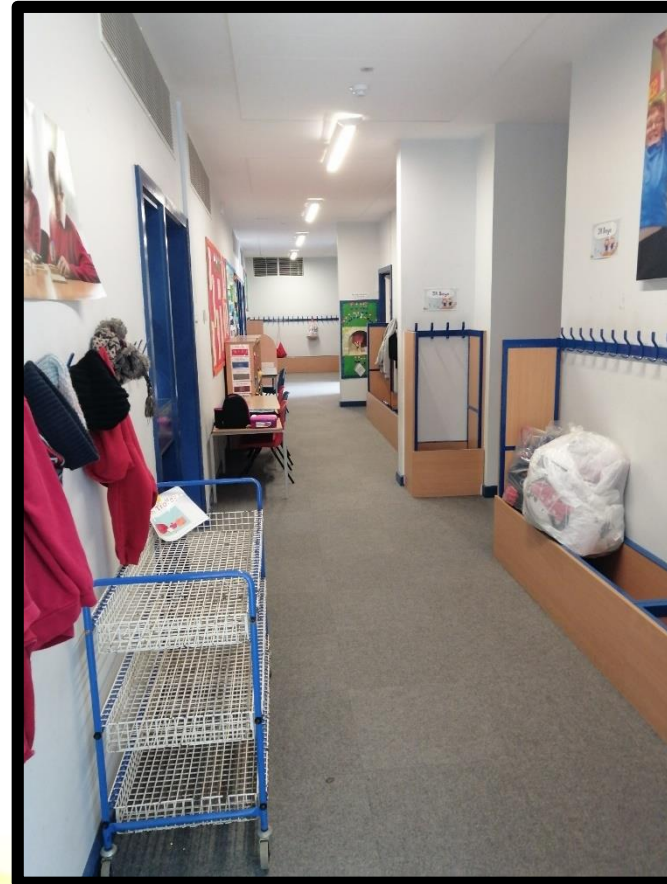
In the Year 3 and 4 building, the Year four classrooms can be found in the lower corridor with our pegs set up just outside our doors.

- Please bring in your Year 3 reading books so that they can be returned to their year group!

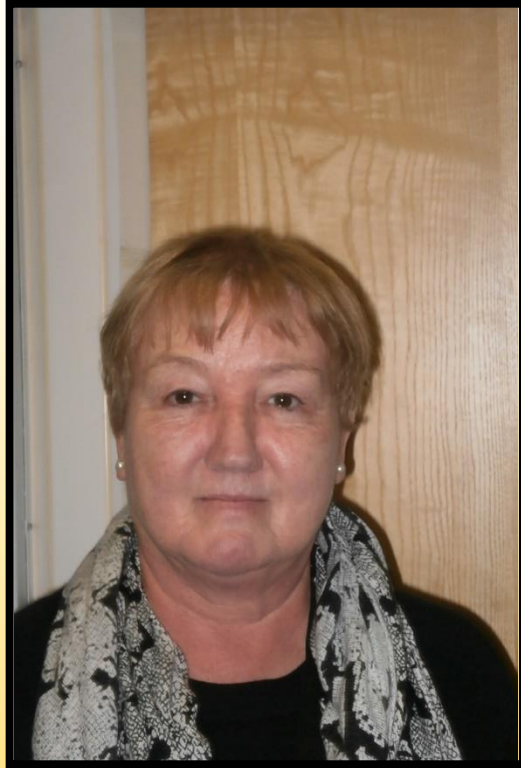


The following slides will tell you who your new year 4 teacher is when you come back to school in September.
