Thank you for your keen interest in supporting your child's learning while not in school. Purple Mash will continue to be our main learning platform and in response to requests for advice we have a **suggested daily plan** that you may like to use.

*The Education Secretary announced some further information on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> April and will be working on adding this to our guidance during this week.*

<b>Each day</b>
1 Maths activity
1 English activity (Including phonics or SPAG)
1 Physical activity (Joe Wicks or your own choice)
Reading- either individual or shared
Times tables and basic addition or subtraction practice
1 other activity. Such as; <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Science</li><li>• Topic</li><li>• Art</li><li>• Personal, Social or Health Education</li><li>• Music</li></ul>

Reception age pupils will continue to access learning through the 'MiniMash' section. Teachers from Years one to six will be uploading new To Do tasks regularly to ensure there are a number available for your child to access through the week. They will also comment on some of the completed work. In Year 3 the pupils learn to use 2email and we encourage all key stage two pupils to access it. This is a secure system which allows your child to only email the teacher but also to receive a response.

We would also like to get to know our pupils interests and encourage pupils to create some of their own projects. These could include;

Choose a country to research	Create a brochure with facts, illustrations and information.
Design a theme park	Art and design work, drawing maps and pricing a visit.
Sporting or animal fact-files	Research online to create illustrations, descriptions and facts.
Or choose any hobby or interest that your child has outside school.
