Miss Wiggins group guidance for home learning:

Please try to read daily (any books, magazines, comics or anything go interest).

Play phonics games at: https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/literacy.html

You may want play games such as: challenge your child to find as may words as they can beginning with a letter 'a' or with the sound 'sh' e.g. shoe.

We are currently working on comprehension. This could be continued at home by asking questions about books such as:

Who are the characters? Are they good or bad? Why do you think this? Where is the story set? What happens first and next? What happens in the end? What was your favourite part? Why?

Encourage your child to retell the story or act it out. Then write their own version of the story. They could draw pictures and be artistic with this!
