Equipment

- Non-stick paper
- Baking tray

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C.
2. Add butter and sugar in a bowl and beat well with light and fluffy.
3. Add the vanilla, mix then add the flour and mix well.
4. Roll out on a floured surface (flour your work surface).
5. Roll to 20 thickness in well-greased tins.
