

### **New Entrance – Carl's Gate.**

We are pleased to announce that our new entrance and gate on Sipson Road is now open. This gate with its wider path leads directly to the school office, instead of the smaller middle gate on Sipson Road. There will still be three ways to enter and exit the school grounds ~ the gate and long path from Cherry Lane, the gate by the Children's Centre leading to the Reception classes and this new gate leading to the year 3 and 4 building and the main playground. Please use this gate now when dropping children to Breakfast Club, for late arrivals, early leavers, visitors and after school collections. Morning Nursery pick up will still be from the same door but please use the gate by the Children's Centre to enter the school grounds.
