'School Keep Clear' Markings

London Borough of Hillingdon will be amending the hours that the 'School Keep Clear' markings close to school entrances operates across Hillingdon. This will ensure the safety of children who will be arriving and leaving school at various times and prevent dangerous or obstructive parking.

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The Council have confirmed that from 7th September, the current time during which the 'School Keep Clear' markings will be enforced will be extended to Monday and Friday 7am to 11am and **1.30pm to 5.30pm** for the reasons stated above. This will initially be implemented on an experimental basis and if and when things change, the situation will be reviewed.

School Uniform Ordering Information

We have made some changes for obtaining school uniform. We will no longer be offering uniform via the school shop.

Booking School Meals via ParentPay

All parents have been notified that all school meals are now available to book online via ParentPay. The cut off time is midnight on every Wednesday to book meals for the following week. Please note that all meals need to be paid for within two hours of making your selection or your pre-booked meals will be lost.

If no meals have been booked you will have to provide a packed lunch for your child. There will be no opportunity to amend any meals after this time. Whatever is booked online will be what your child is having on the relevant day. Please note if you have pre booked a meal for your child and decide to send them in with a packed lunch, they will be given the pre-booked meal and the packed lunch will be sent home with them at the end of the day.

COVID-19 Symptoms

If someone in your household has symptoms of COVID-19 however mild (high temperature OR a new continuous cough OR loss of, or change in, sense of taste and smell), they must self-isolate for at least 10 days from when the symptoms started. They should arrange to have a test to see if they have COVID-19. All other household members need to stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days. The 14-day period starts from the day when the first person in the household became ill. If anyone else in the household starts displaying symptoms, they need to stay at home for at least 10 days from when their symptoms appear, regardless of what day they are on in their original 14-day isolation period.

You must inform school if any members of your household have any symptoms.

Pupils in this household will only be allowed back to school following proof of a negative COVID-19 test (for the person who displayed the symptoms) or after the full isolation period.

If your email address has changed please update your details in your Parentpay account as this is where we obtain your details from.


