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School Office

There will be NO ENTRY into the school office. Entry is by prior arrangement only so please telephone the school or email on <u>admin@cherrylane.hillingdon.sch.uk</u>.

Reporting an absence

If your child is absent from school due to illness or will miss registration due to attending a medical appointment you <u>MUST</u> contact the school office either by phone and <u>NOT</u> their Class Teacher. All absences must be reported by 9am on each morning of your child's absence. If the school office has not been notified of your child's absence you will receive an automated message, known as a Truancy Call.

Truancy Call

Truancy Call is a daily automated messaging service that is sent to all mobile phone numbers, of parent/carers with parental responsibility, of children absent from school. These calls <u>MUST</u> be responded to as it is a safeguarding issue for children not attending school. Failing to respond to these calls will result in your child's absence being recorded as <u>UNAUTHORISED</u>. These calls are monitored by our Attendance Officer, Mrs Ramsay, who may refer your details to the Local Authority for non-attendance.

Medical Appointments

All Doctor, Dental and Hospital appointments wherever possible must be made out of the school day. If this is not possible you must notify the school office of dates, times and **provide** medical evidence whether it is in the form of a text, email. If an appointment has been made over the phone you **must** provide proof of your attendance. If no evidence is seen by the office staff your child's absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

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School Uniform Ordering Information

We have made some changes for obtaining school uniform. We will no longer be offering uniform via the school shop.

Booking School Meals via ParentPay

All parents have been notified that all school meals are now available to book online via ParentPay. The cut off time is midnight on every Wednesday to book meals for the following week. **Please note that all meals need to be paid for within two hours of making your selection or your pre-booked meals will be lost.**

If no meals have been booked you will have to provide a packed lunch for your child. There will be no opportunity to amend any meals after this time. Whatever is booked online will be what your child is having on the relevant day. **Please note if you have pre booked a meal for your child and decide to send them in with a packed lunch, they will be given the pre-booked meal and the packed lunch will be sent home with them at the end of the day.**


