Hand Sanitiser

It has been brought to our attention that some pupils are colouring their own hand sanitiser and then bringing it to school. If any of our pupils bring coloured hand sanitiser to school it will be taken off them until the end of the day. We have enough hand sanitiser in school to ensure pupils will still be able to sanitise their hands.

Parentpay

All correspondence from the school to parents is via Parentpay in the form of text or email. If you have not registered with Parentpay and have mislaid your login details you <u>must</u> contact the school office as a matter of urgency so you will get up to date notifications of any Year Group bubble closures/re-openings.

Covid-19 Test Results

If your child/children or a family member have been advised to get a COVID-19 test and self-isolate as a result of showing signs of COVID the results must be provided to the school via email, along with the date of which the test was taken, on admin@cherrylane.hillingdon.sch.uk before the children can return to school.

Please remember that there are two **Entrance Only** gates and two **Exit Only** gates on the premises. Please use the correct gates for entering and exiting the school site as this forms part of the safety measures we have put in place to try to keep everyone safe on the school grounds. Birthday Sweets / Cakes

Some families like to send sweets etc to celebrate children's birthdays with their classmates. To keep this safe during the pandemic, here is a list of do's and don'ts:

- Children can bring sweets to share
- Sweets/Cakes <u>MUST</u> be brought in at the start of the day with your child and given to their class teacher
- They should be in individual sealed packages (eg like a big bag with little Haribo type packets etc)
- Loose individually wrapped sweets can be shared so long as they are sent to school in their large sealed packet or container at the start of the day
- Open unwrapped sweets or cakes etc cannot be accepted or given out at all
- School staff will hand out the treats at the end of the day, to limit the amount of physical contact with the gifts
- Children are asked to put sweets etc in their bag to take home. They do not eat them in class. It is up to their parent when and if they eat them, not school staff.
