National Lockdown – school update

UPCOMING

As you will already be aware, England will be under new National Coronavirus Restrictions. During this time, the government have said that school will remain open. In light of this, we are making a few changes to enhance the safety of our school community. We ask for your support and cooperation with these new measures.

With immediate effect, please follow these measures:

- Parents / Carers coming onto the school site should wear a mask during drop off and pick up times, unless you are medically exempt from wearing one.
- Only speak to teachers / LSAs at drop off and pick up times if it is absolutely necessary. All other messages / queries should be made by email or phone and someone will get back to you. School staff will wear visors at their doors during drop off and pick up times.
- Limit conversations with other parents / carers and leave the site as soon as you have dropped off / picked up your children.

We would like to remind you of the other measures we already have in place:

• Use social distancing whilst waiting at arrival and collection times and moving around site.

- Use social distancing if you must talk to a member of staff at the beginning or end of the day.
- Only queue at the school gates at year group drop off and pick up time if you arrive early please wait away from the gates eg. on the grass verge opposite.
- Stay on site, whilst still distancing from others, once your first child has been dropped off or picked up.
- Follow any one way systems on site eg. entrances and exits.
- Do not enter the school buildings, including the office unless it has been arranged with the school.
- Only one adult per family group can come onto site. Any other family members should wait outside the school site.
