I hope you all had a great Easter break and were able to enjoy yourselves now that the restrictions are gradually being lifted. In terms of school procedures our guidance remains pretty much unchanged. The one aspect that has been updated is around trips and after school activities.

Therefore, we are currently liaising with the companies who used to deliver our after school clubs and hopefully we can gradually begin to offer some after school activities in the coming weeks.

The Government have said that schools can resume educational day visits from 12<sup>th</sup> April. Therefore, each year group is currently looking into possible class trips for June or July. All bookings will be provisional and any visit will be conducted in line with COVID-19 guidelines and regulations in place at that time.

The Government hope to announce that domestic residential educational visits will be able to commence from the 17<sup>th</sup> May. The year 6 PGL residential trip is booked for 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021 and we hope that finally the pupils will be able to enjoy their trip away. The week away will be conducted in line with relevant coronavirus (COVID-19) secure guidance and regulations in place at that time, as well as those set by PGL.

We are looking forward to an exciting term ahead and with the warmer weather, classes are planning their curriculum so they can make use of the school grounds and local area as much as possible.
