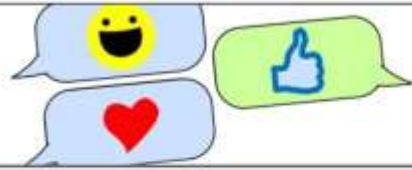
Afterschool Clubs (Ballet/Games/Martial Arts & Games)

We will be re-introducing the Afterschool Clubs from week commencing 10th May. A form will be sent out via email so please check your emails to register your child's interest in starting the clubs.

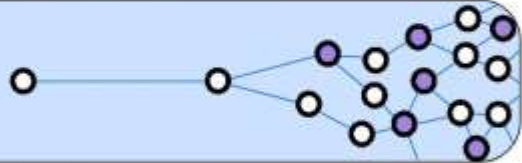

1 Be nice to people online.



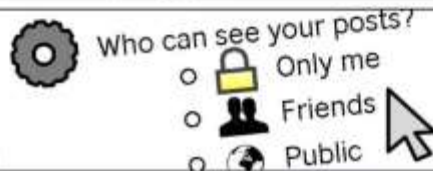
