Late Pick-up

It is unacceptable to collect your child late from school. Unless it is exceptional circumstances (ie traffic/ buses etc) and you know you are going to be late picking up your child/children from school please inform the school office as soon as possible and they will notify the class teacher. **Parents who are collecting their children late, after informing the school office, will need to collect their child/children from the Staff entrance and NOT the school office.**

However, if we do not hear anything from you your child/children will be brought to the school office and a telephone call will be made to see who is picking your child/children up. Failure to respond to the call or an expected late pick up (ie later than 10 minutes), your child will be taken to Fit for Sport where you will be charged for using their facilities.

Over the next coming weeks please look out for information of your child's school trip on their ParentPay accounts.

There are two options to pay, either by ParentPay (online) or the PayPoint facility (cash). If you would like to pay cash in a local store please contact the school office and they will print a letter for you. It will have a barcode that will be allocated to your child's ParentPay account when you complete payment in store.

Parental consent must be given to authorise your child's attendance on their trip so please submit the ParentPay information form once you have received it.

Stay safe online

Remember the 5 SMART rules when using the Internet and mobile phones.



S SAFE: Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information – such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name – to people you are chatting with online.

M MEET: Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.

A ACCEPTING: Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems – they may contain viruses or nasty messages!

R RELIABLE: Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are. Make sure you check information before you believe it.

T TELL: Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.
