#### **Free School Meal Entitlement**

Since September 2014 all children who are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 in a state-funded school have been entitled to a free healthy school lunch. The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families do their very best. This funding is called 'Pupil Premium'.

Registering for free meals could raise an extra £1,300 for Cherry Lane Primary School, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.

During the current pandemic, some parents may have become eligible but not know - it is therefore important to sign up for free school meals, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, so that Cherry Lane Primary School receives as much funding as possible and your family receives as much support as possible during these challenging times.


#### Year 2's moving into Year 3

From September all Year 2 children moving into Year 3 will have to pay for their school lunches. The cost of the school meals are £2 per day and will have to be booked in the normal way via Parentpay.

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals or you are unsure as to whether they are entitled to Free School Meals please click on the link below (or copy and paste it to your browser) and submit the form as soon as possible.

After you have submitted the form, via the link, we will run the check on your behalf and the school office will telephone you to confirm if you are eligible or not eligible for Free School Meals.

#### FROM SEPTEMBER .....

There will be the original start and finish times –

Nursery Times:
Morning 8.30am to 11.30am
Afternoon 12.30am to 3.30pm
Key Stage One (Reception, Years 1 & 2)
Start: 8.50am to 3.20pm
Key Stage Two (Years, 3, 4, 5 & 6)
Start: 8.45am to 3.25pm

In the morning, all gates will be open in time for breakfast club arrival and at the end of the day gates will reopen at 3:10pm. Any gates may be used for either entrance or exit.

- Parents will continue to come onto the premises to drop off and collect their children. We will continue with Reception, year 1, year 2 and year 4 dropping and collecting at their classroom doors. Year 3 will continue using the remaining external doors to the new building and year 5 and 6 will carry on using external doors onto the main playground.
- All usual timetables will resume. We will go back to two separate playtimes in the main playground, one for Key Stage 1 and one for Key Stage 2. All year groups will eat lunch in the hall as before. Reception children will continue to play in their reception play area.
- You will still be able to send your child into school with a small hand sanitiser and a pack of tissues, however these will still be provided by the school.

#### Standard Tuition (Group Music Lessons)

Arrangements for all music lessons are subject to change in line with current COVID restrictions. In the event of school closures lessons will take place online with individual slots.

Learning to sing or play an instrument can help concentration, confidence and coordination as well as being great fun!

If your child goes to a school in the borough or lives in the borough, we can arrange for them to have music lessons during the school day at their school or on some occasions at one of our centres at various locations across the borough. Lesson times are set by the school to fit with their timetables so exact lesson times will vary from school to school. We deliver 10 lessons each term.

#### How much are music lessons?

If you are a Hillingdon resident, lessons cost £74.00 per term plus £21.00 to hire an instrument (hire not available for guitar, keyboard or drums). See our website for non-resident prices. Discounts are available to those on low incomes.

For families receiving Income Support, Child Tax Credit WITHOUT Working Tax Credit (income below £16,190), Income Based Job Seekers Allowance the charge is £16.00 per term plus  $\pounds$ 7.00 per term for the use of an instrument

#### How do I apply?

Visit www.hillingdon.gov.uk/startmusic

Once you complete the application form, you will be added to our waiting list and a member of our team will be in contact once a lesson time becomes available. Sometimes this will happen quickly, other times there may be a delay if there are no available times or if the school has limited time or space for lessons.

#### How do I pay for lessons?

You will be invoiced before the start of the first lesson. Once payment for lessons has been received Hillingdon Music Hub will provide ten lessons per term on a rolling contract, unless the lessons start partway through a term.

#### Can I hire an instrument?

When you sign for lessons you can choose hire an instrument. Once payment is received you can collect your instrument, details of where and when this can be done are available on our website. Alternatively you can purchase your own with our Assisted Instrument Purchase (AIP) scheme, details of which are on our website.

#### My child no longer wants to learn, how do I cancel lessons?

We always encourage parents to persist with lessons for at least a term in the beginning. If there are any problems with lessons, you can contact us on music@hillingdon.gov.uk If you would still like to cancel tuition, we require half a term's written notice. Please refer to our Terms and Conditions for more information.
