Miss Houria will be moving role to be one of our HLTA's.

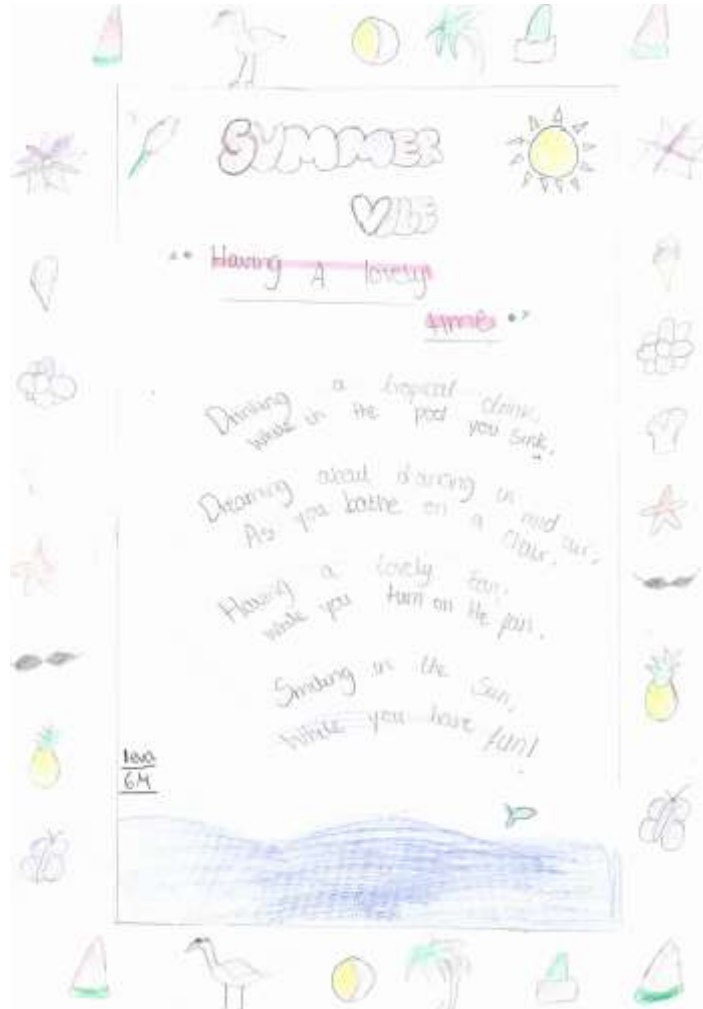
Miss Humphries will be joining us as Small Groups Teacher.
