Please make sure Mrs. Ramsay has been updated with any changes to your child's medical condition.


### Absence and appointments

# Edition 5 Topic – Winter activities

We have created a list of some 'free' winter activities. With prices rising and school holidays looming we are aware parents maybe feeling anxious. Here are some ideas to keep the children busy. These 'free' winter activities children can do are perfect for keeping their days occupied while it is cold and often dreary outside. Grab a few things you have around the house already, and have a ton of fun during the cooler winter months with your children.

Go on a Scavenger hunt and look for wildlife too. Play a board game or card game. Make hot chocolate. Colour in. Complete a jigsaw or make your own using cardboard. Read a book – you could visit the local library. Have a movie day. Visit a free museum. Pick up litter in your local area. Cook or bake as a family. Build an indoor camp / fort or put up a tent in the garden (wrap up warm). Go for a walk or bike ride and maybe explore somewhere new. Have a sing-song, create a family dance or act out your own play. You could do a sock puppet play. Make some musical instruments Play at the park. Do some arts and craft. You could find a rock to paint and hide in the local area or make a snowflake. Write a letter to family of friend and post it. Create a scrapbook Build an obstacle course (jumping, crawling and running) Have an indoor picnic or tea party Make some gifts for family and friends or make a calendar for next year. Learn a new sport Donate unwanted toys or clothes. Make a time capsule. You could bury it outside. Learn how to sew or draw using you tube or books from the library. Play with bubbles. Explore some science experiments and carry out some basic ones. Feed the birds. Write a story.
