# School Lunches

There are an increasing number of children coming to school without a lunch booked via Parent Pay or without a packed lunch.

This not only causes a problem for the office and the kitchen but it is also upsetting for the child/children.

Please ensure that all school lunches are booked by 9pm every Wednesday for the following week. Please do not leave it until last minute to book because if there are any problems or you are not sure what to do, the school office will not be able to help.

If meals haven't been booked on time, **there are no exceptions**, you **MUST** provide a packed lunch for your child. This must be brought into school with them 1<sup>st</sup> thing for morning registration every day for the whole week.

On many occasions, children are informing their class teacher that their parents will be bringing lunches in for them, however, when it gets to lunchtime nothing has been brought in and this is causing many problems.

It is not acceptable to send your child to school with no lunch provided at all.


