Testing Positive for Covid19

From Monday 17 January, pupils who are self-isolating after testing positive for COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day at least 24 hours later. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace on <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result>.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take Lateral Flow tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

Any pupil that is showing symptoms **MUST** take a PCR test. This can be booked online on <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test> or telephone 119.

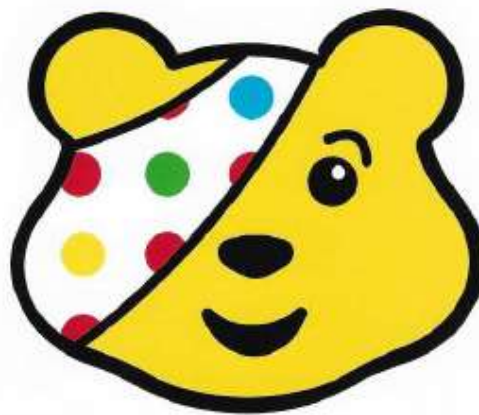

Absence from School

It is vitally important that the school be notified of all absences of children from school. This includes, appointments (eg. hospital/doctors/dental/opticians), religious celebration etc. This should be done in writing via email to the Attendance Officer, Mrs Ramsay on kramsay2.312@lgflmail.org with medical evidence attached. If the absence is for an appointment, then the appointment card or letter should be given to the school office if not emailed. If the absence involves travel abroad, then a copy of the booking information/tickets will be required. By doing this, we are able to provide an accurate account of where the child was that session, thus preventing an unauthorised absence on the child's attendance record. We thank you for your co-operation with this matter.
