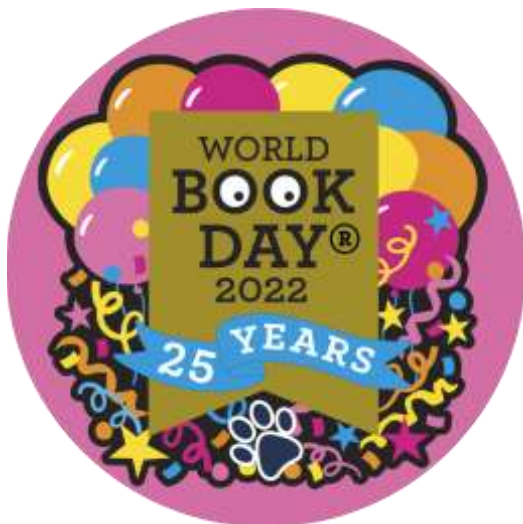

### Absence from School

It is vitally important that the school be notified of all absences of children from school. All sickness must be reported to the school office via telephone by 9am each morning of your child's absence. All appointments (eg. hospital/doctors/dental/opticians), religious celebration etc must be put in writing via email on [admin@cherrylane.hillingdon.sch.uk](mailto:admin@cherrylane.hillingdon.sch.uk) with all medical evidence attached or a copy of the appointment letter must be given to the school office. By doing this, we are able to provide an accurate account of where your child was that session, thus preventing an unauthorised absence on the child's attendance record. If the absence involves travel abroad, then a copy of the booking information/tickets will be required. We thank you for your co-operation with this matter.

### Parking Issues

Unfortunately, we have had some local residents complain about illegal and dangerous parking outside the school. We do understand that there is limited parking but we would ask that you consider the residents around the school and do not park anywhere that is not legal, ie double yellow lines. We would also like to remind you once again to not park in front of residents' driveways along Sipson Road and Keats Way.

### Parking Camera

There is a camera that overlooks the zig zag lines and the entrance to the school gates that has been installed by The London Borough of Hillingdon. This camera is in force 24 hours per day and tickets will be issued to anyone who is stationary in their vehicle within the covered area. Any problems should be directed to the London Borough of Hillingdon and not to the school.
