## Reminders:

- School begins promptly at: Nursery AM-8:30-11:30, Nursery PM-12:30-3:30, Nursery all day 8:30-3:30, KS1-8:50-3:20, KS2-8:45-3:25. **Please ensure your child is on time for school.**
- If your child attends Breakfast Club, it starts at 7:45am. Please DO NOT drop your children off before this time.
- Extra-curricular clubs are due to start week commencing 15<sup>th</sup> September.
- Please do not forget to book your child's lunch via ParentPay. They need to be booked before Wednesday for the following week. If you miss the cut off please contact the office first thing on Thursday and we can accommodate, otherwise you will need to provide packed lunch.
- Please remember breakfast club **MUST** be booked and paid for in advance via ParentPay. The cut off for booking is the evening before. There is a £2 charge per child per day. Children will have the option to have a healthy breakfast of either toast or cereal. **Please make sure you clear current debt.**
- Please can you name all uniform, especially jumpers and cardigans!

**We use ParentPay to send text messages and emails updating parents, please make sure you're mobile number is correct on your ParentPay account. If you're mobile number is missing or incorrect you will not receive any urgent notifications from us.**

Please note children should not be dropped off into the playground on their own. The playground is not staffed the children **will not** be supervised. If your child is found in the playground, they will be placed in breakfast club and you will be charged.

Year 6 PGL Residential Activity Week Wednesday 18th to Friday 20th March 2026

Next year's residential activity centre will be held at PGL Liddington, Swindon. Cherry Lane have enjoyed many trips there in the past and are very excited to be returning. There will be a variety of exciting activities to engage the children which are all supervised by fully trained members of staff.

Children who attend these residential trips learn so much and benefit greatly in so many ways. We see the children who go to PGL grow emotionally, become more independent, gain confidence and make new friends.

As this is such an extremely valuable experience for the children the School Governors have, once again, agreed to help in the funding of this trip to help reduce the cost to parents.

The cost to parents/carers will be £250 for the trip, including accommodation, all meals, travel by coach and all activities.

Families will have the opportunity to pay in full or in instalments via their child's ParentPay account or pay cash using the Pay point facility available through local stores using the barcode at the bottom of this letter.

A polite reminder that if you would like your child to participate in next year's PGL trip the deadline to secure their place has been extended to Monday 8th Sept, a non-refundable deposit of £45 is due by this date. The payment item will be closed after this date so if you change your mind there may be limited availability for this trip. Please see all the details on their ParentPay accounts.


