


Friday 24th October – Training Day – School closed to pupils

- If your child attends Breakfast Club, it starts at 7:45am. Please DO NOT drop your children off before this time.

- Please do not forget to book your child's lunch via ParentPay. They need to be booked before Wednesday for the following week. If you miss the cut off please contact the office first thing on Thursday and we can accommodate, otherwise you will need to provide packed lunch.
- Please remember breakfast club <u>MUST</u> be booked and paid for in advance via ParentPay. The cut off for booking is the evening before. There is a £2 charge per child per day. Children will have the option to have a healthy breakfast of either toast or cereal. Please make sure you clear current debt.
