Important Safety Reminder: Bikes and Scooters on School Grounds

No scooters or bikes are to be use on school grounds

To help keep everyone safe and prevent accidents in the playground, **riding bikes or scooters is not permitted on the school site before or after school.**

If your child cycles or scooters to school, please ensure they **dismount as soon as they enter the school grounds** and walk their bike or scooter to one of the designated storage areas.

We have **three bike sheds** available:

- Near the **front gate**
- By the **MUGA (Multi-Use Games Area)**
- Through the **playground**

Please remind your child **not to leave bikes or scooters on the ground**, as they can become trip hazards or block access to gates and pathways. It's everyone's responsibility to help keep our school safe and accident-free. **Thank you for your cooperation and continued support.**




School Trips


