Girls will need a one-piece costume (Bikinis are not allowed) and a swimming cap.

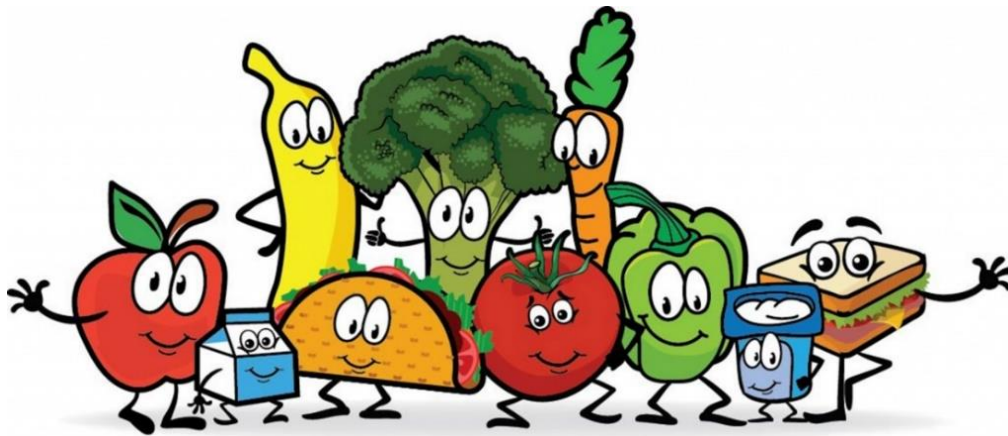

Year 6 SATS information

Year 6 SATS

The Key stage 2 SATs take place nationally in the week commencing Monday 13th - Thursday 16th May.

Statutory tests will be administered in the following subject areas on the following days:

Monday: Grammar and punctuation (45minutes)
Spellings (approx. 20minutes)

Tuesday: Reading (60minutes)

Wednesday: Paper 1: Arithmetic (30minutes) -Mathematics
Paper 2 Reasoning (40 minutes) -Mathematics

Thursday: Paper 3: Reasoning (40minutes) -Mathematics

All tests are externally marked.

Writing will be 'Teacher Assessed' internally.

- SATs are a useful tool to see how well a child has progressed from KS1 to KS2, and they also give secondary schools a base to compare against when the time comes for your child to leave Year 6 and make the journey up to KS3!
- In school, teachers have been working hard with all children to ensure they have covered all of the Year 6 curriculum. Year 6 children have done Mock SATs earlier in Year 6 so they know what to expect next week.
- All Year 6 pupils are invited to our free breakfast club next week (Monday-Thursday) from 8am-8.30pm. This will help children to be in school on time. Pupils attending breakfast club will be coming in from the double doors into the downstairs hall (as normal breakfast club).
- The KS2 assessments only include questions on things that children have already been taught as part of the national curriculum.
- If a pupil misses his/her SATs test and returns to school during test week, the school will ensure the pupil is supervised and is able to complete the test at the earliest time available. The pupil will be supervised so there is no opportunity for the pupil to discuss test content with anyone else.
- Please try and ensure your child is in school and on time next week.
