We identify and practise key vocabulary - children record and explore this vocabulary in various contexts

Our emphasis on vocabulary development enables pupils to understand and articulate key learning.

We learn actively – children undertake practical activities which are recorded through photographs and recounts

We seek to make learning practical and interactive whenever possible. We reflect on these experiences to enhance our understanding.

We can explain what we know and understand – children talk about their learning and consider Next Step Questions
