## TOPIC WEB

### **ART: Sculpture and 3D: Making memories**

Children learn to represent memories through art, using various materials and techniques, and develop skills in planning, creating, and evaluating 3D sculptures. We will: learn about a non-European society – the Mayan civilisation c. 900ad – that provides contrasts with British history • gain a coherent knowledge and understanding of Britain's past and that of the wider world • know and understand significant aspects of the history of the wider world, including characteristic features of past non-European societies.
